### **Course structure**

The B1 German *idoneità* course is a blended course: in addition to classroom lessons, students carry out activities on the Moodle platform. At the beginning of the course the teacher will give the students the enrolment password and will explain how to work autonomously on Moodle.

### **Objectives**

The course aims to provide participants with all the linguistic tools necessary to understand and have a simple conversation, as well as to speak and write in everyday working life and free time, on familiar topics and personal interests. Students will be able to express and understand short reasons, explanations and opinions (according to the level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages: <https://www.goethe.de/ins/it/it/spr/kon/stu.html>).

### **Contents**

Grammatical structures of basic German are explored in depth through reading, listening to and watching audio and video excerpts, dialogue practice and composition of short texts.

**The final exam** consists of the following **parts**:

- evaluation of grammatical structures and vocabulary (without dictionary)
- listening test (without dictionary)
- writing (e.g. an email, the description of a party, etc.. A paper dictionary is permitted)
- comprehension of a written text (a paper dictionary is permitted)
- speaking: a conversation about the topics covered during the course / optional: an oral presentation

**Please note:** Enrolment in the exam is compulsory to be able to record it in your university transcript of records and to request a CLA certificate. Language proficiency exams (*idoneità*) only award credits (CFU), without a mark out of thirty.

Students who pass the exam will receive a digital **Open Badge**, certifying the achievement of level B1 in German, in reference to the CEFR.
