1st YEAR

1st semester: B2.A

At the end of the first semester, anybody who doesn't have an English certificate, will take the **B1 idoneità**. This is similar to the Cambridge PET exam but there is no speaking component. You have to have passed the idoneità (or have a recognised B1 certificate such as PET) in order to access the mono 1 exam.

2nd semester: B2.B

At the end of the second semester, (June) you take **Mono 1**, which is based on the Cambridge First exam and consists of the following:

- Use of English
- Reading
- Listening
- Writing
- Speaking

The exam is divided into Part 1 (Use of E, Reading and Listening) and Part 2 (writing and speaking). You have to **pass** part 1 in order to **access** part 2.

AND ...

You have **to pass** mono I to be able to take **mediazione 1**.
Your final mark in /30 will be an **average** of mono 1 and med 1.

2nd YEAR

1st semester: C1.A

2nd semester: C1.B

At the end of the second semester, in June, you will take **Mono 2**.
This consists of the following components:

- Use of English
- Reading
- Listening

And is based on the Cambridge Advanced exam.

As with mono 1, this is a prerequisite to taking med 2 and your mark is an average of the 2 exams.

3rd YEAR

1st semester: C1.C

This is your last semester of English mono, and at the end (January/February) you take **Mono 3**.
This consists of **Listening, Speaking and Writing**.
